QUALIFICATIONS

- Must possess Grade 12 education and have the ability to read and write in English.**
- Previous hospital laundry experience and previous sewing and mending experience would be considered assets.**
- Must possess the physical ability to stand most of the working day and sufficient strength to push loaded hand trucks. To lift and carry laundry bundles, to turn, to stoop, to reach for, to handle and lift laundered articles when working with the folding machines, to load and unload washers and dryers, to push and pull levers and handles to open and close washer drums, doors and valves.**
- Must possess the ability to work in a limited area most of the day.**
- Must have the physical strength to meet the Jobs Demands Analysis for the Laundry Aide and Washer/Helper Porter tasks.**
- Must possess the ability to work inside with damp articles in a moist saturated atmosphere, in extreme heat during the summer time and the capacity to work while exposed to loud, steady noise from washing, drying and extracting machines.**
- Must be able to work around cleaning chemicals and blood products.**
- Must possess the willingness to perform routine, repetitive tasks on a continuous basis.**
- Must possess the mathematical skills to tabulate poundage.**
- Must be able to work without supervision.**
- Must be alert, possess a good memory, and the willingness to adapt to change.**
- Must have excellent communication skills, pleasant personality and evidence of tact and diplomacy.**
- Must have a good work ethic and work record demonstrating regular attendance at work.**
