Registered Dietitian – Regional Eating Disorder Program

POSITION SUMMARY: An exciting role working with the Eating Disorder interdisciplinary team. The registered dietitian will work closely with the Regional Eating Disorder Program to develop and offer a Regional Intensive Day Treatment Program (Level 3). The dietitian will assist children, youth and adults registered with the program by providing nutrition counselling and education.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide comprehensive assessments and nutritional planning according to evidence-based practice guidelines.
- Accurately complete clinical documentation and work load measurement as outlined by the quality improvement framework.
- Participate as an active member of the multidisciplinary team.
- Provide detailed analysis of nutritional needs and recommendations, patient and parental support related to eating and feeding.
- Provide care for medically and psychiatrically stable clients who require intensive interdisciplinary treatment and family based therapy and support but for whom in patient medical monitoring is not required.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Bachelors degree in Food and Nutrition.
- Successful completion of a dietetic internship program accredited by the Dietitians of Canada.
- Membership in good standing with the College of Dietitians of Ontario.
- Preferred two (2) years recent clinical nutrition experience in health care setting.
- Considerable experience in family assessment/treatment planning.
- Strong written and verbal interpersonal and communications skills required.
- Demonstrated ability to prioritize and work effectively in fast-paced environment.
- Demonstrated patient centered philosophy of care.
- Demonstrated commitment to continuous learning.
- Proficient with computer applications (Word, Excel, internet, etc.)
