Social Worker Eating Disorders Program

POSITION SUMMARY: To provide quality psychotherapy and supportive social worker services to clients registered with the Regional Eating Disorders Program. The Social Worker will support children, youth and adult clients, and their families by delivering therapy specific to eating disorder diagnoses. Care is provided within the standards of the Ontario College of Certified Social Workers and Social Service Workers and the policies and procedures of the Timmins and District Hospital. The Social Worker will work closely to develop and offer a Regional Intensive Day Treatment Program (Level 3) in collaboration with other programs within the Northeast region.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- The Social Worker will provide intervention to clients registered to the Regional Eating Disorders Program in collaboration with the multi-disciplinary healthcare team, community service providers and families.
- To complete psycho social assessments and plan for effective intervention strategies for clients diagnosed with an eating disorder.
- Assist in the provision of eating disorder specific therapy modalities to patients such as: CBT-T, CBT-E, and FBT.
- Provide comprehensive assessments and case management according to evidence-based practice guidelines.
- Accurately complete clinical documentation and work load measurement as outlined by the quality improvement framework.
- Provide care for medically and psychiatrically stable clients who require intensive interdisciplinary treatment and family based therapy and support but for whom inpatient medical monitoring is not required.
- Collaborate with the health care team to provide goal directed interventions and to reach identified client outcomes.
- Maintain collaborative relationships with individuals and community organizations that provide services to the client.
- Connect with and develop relationships with community and district stakeholders.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Masters of Social Work or working toward a Master's of Social Work.
- Must be a member of the Ontario College of Certified Social Workers and Social Service Workers.
- Must be eligible for membership with the Ontario Association of Social Workers.
- Minimum of 2 years of current mental health experience with knowledge of major diagnoses and the pharmacology associated with the treatment of these illnesses
- Considerable experience in family assessment/treatment planning.

- Experience in working with clients with an eating disorder diagnosis or other mental health diagnoses.
- Experience in program development.
- Knowledge of eating disorder specific therapy modalities (i.e. FBT, CBT-E, CBT-T).
- Working knowledge of the signs and symptoms of addictions and mental health diagnoses, risk indicators, and the potential impact of addictions and mental illness on family members.
- Current CPR.
- Experience with data entry, Windows programs, and Meditech.
- Working knowledge of developing rapport with clients who have poor distress tolerance and emotion regulation challenges.
- Must possess the verbal ability to communicate with patients, physicians, program staff and other stakeholders in order to give and receive information or instructions and to write clear and accurate reports.
- Must have the ability to function as a member of a multi-disciplinary health care team.
- Must possess the ability to provide effective services to clients/patients in both English and French. Individuals who do not meet the language requirements of this posting are invited to submit their résumé for future consideration.
- Must possess the physical ability to work while sitting; to bend, reach, lift and crouch when using departmental files and to travel distances in the department and Hospital.
- Must be willing to deliver services virtually, via telephone, and in person to those within the Timmins and District Hospital catchment area. Must possess the ability to provide effective services to clients/patients in both English and French.
- Employment history, which demonstrates regular attendance at work.
- Must be vaccinated against COVID-19.

Compensation and Benefits

- Starting salary of \$44.67/hour; \$87,106.50/year (As per Step 1 of the OPSEU collective agreement.)
- Option to enroll into Healthcare of Ontario Pension Plan.
